What?

The Tribal Language Educators' Professional Learning Community (PLC) is designed to offer support to Tribal language educators and leaders across the state. We share best or promising practices, past projects, future goals, and instructional strategies. There will also be sessions to ask questions and think around and through problems, speed bumps, and possibilities.

When?

Tribal Language Educators' PLCs will be offered twice a month, on the **first and third Thursday from 4:00–5:00 PM starting 9/22**. The first Thursday of the month will be reserved for sharing about language and culture programs. The third Thursday of the month will be a time to network, ask questions, and receive support; as well as a place for feedback and thought partnership.
