

Civic Education Travel

1. **Purpose:** The Civic Education Travel grant program is created to provide travel grants to students participating in statewide, regional, national, or international civic education competitions or events.
2. **Description of services provided:** Schools may be awarded up to \$10,000 for past and/or future travel, depending on the amount of applicants, with \$500 being the least amount awarded.
3. **Criteria for receiving services and/or grants:** Schools must meet the following criteria to be considered for grant selection:
 - a. Students must be residents of the state of Washington;
 - b. Students must use the grants to fund travel to civic education-based competitions or events;
 - c. Students must be participants in the civic education competition or event; and
 - d. Students must be under the age of twenty-one and not yet have received their high school diploma.
