**The McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act npaj muaj kev tiv thaiv qee yam.**

**Koj los yog koj cov menyuam muaj cai:**

- Mus kawm ntawv, txawm tias koj nyob qhov twg los yog tau nyob ntawd ntev li cas los lawm.
- Kawm ntawv ntawm lub tsev kawm ntawv uas koj cov menyuam yeej ib txwm kawm ua ntej koj tsis muaj tsev nyob, yog los lub tsev kawm dhau los yog qhov ntawd yog qhov koj nyiam thiab muaj chaw.
- Tau tsheb cajj mus ntawm lub tsev kawm ntawv uas koj/kov cov menyuam kawm ua ntej koj tsis muaj tsev nyob, los yog lub law kawm dhau los, yog koj, niam txiv los yog tus saib menyuam thov tsev kawm ntawv kom muab tsheb thauj.
- Mus kawm ntawv thiab kom txhua yam nrog lwm tus tub/ntxhais kawm ntawv uas tsis yog neeg tsis muaj tsev nyob.
- Mus sau npe kawm ntawv txawm tias tsis muaj chaw nyob nruaj nrees.
- Tso npe thiab kawm ntawv thaum tsev kawm ntawv nrhiav tej kev kawm uas dhos koj thiab koj tej ntaub ntawv tiv mob.
- Mus tso npe thiab mus kawm ntawv ntawm lub tsev kawm ntawv ua koj xaiv tau ntawd thiab koj tseem sib tham txog tej kev sib txawv/kov cov menyuam yuav kawm lub twg tiag.
- Tau txais txhua yam kev pab ntawm tsev kawm ntawv xws li txhua txhua tus menyuam.
- Tau tsheb cajj mus kawm ntawv thiab mus koom txhua yam tsev kawm ntawv txoj kev yuav ua ib yam dab tsi los yog pab.
- Thov koom txoos (district) tus neeg cev lus rau cov tsi muaj tsev nyob pab thov khoom noj, khaub ncaws, thiab khoom siv kawm ntawv.

**Koj kuj hu tau rau tus cev lus hauv xeev ntawm tus xov toaj:**

**If You or your family...**

- live with relatives or friends because you can't find or afford housing on your own;
- live on the street;
- live in an abandoned building, trailer or a building with inadequate accommodations (these conditions may include lack of electricity, plumbing or running water); or
- live in a shelter, motel, vehicle or campground.

**The McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act provides certain protections.**

**You or your children have the right to:**

- Go to school, no matter where you live or how long you have lived there.
- Continue to go to the school you/your children were attending before becoming homeless, or the school last attended, if that is your preference and it is feasible.
- Receive transportation to the school you/your children attended before becoming homeless, or the school last attended, if you, a parent or guardian asks the school for this transportation.
- Go to school and attend school programs with students who are not homeless.
- Enroll in school without giving a permanent address.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school arranges for needed educational and medical records.
- Enroll and attend classes in the school of your choice even while the school and you resolve differences over which school you/your children will attend.
- Receive the same special programs and services given to all other students.
- Receive transportation to school and to school programs.
- Ask the school district's homeless liaison for help in getting food, clothing, and school supplies.

**You and your children may be able to receive:**

- Free school lunch
- Free school books and supplies
- Free bus tickets (tokens)
- Transportation to school programs
- Other benefits
